Pastor Joseph preached an illustrated message entitled "The Eyes of Faith", using Numbers 13:33 as his text. He displayed several visual illusions on the screen, to show that: an object can appear completely different based solely on perception; our minds can "see" something that is not really there and/or can "see" something that is impossible—our minds can "see" something false. The point? Our eyes—and our minds—are not always reliable. We need to trust God more than our perception. We need to look at life with the eyes of faith. This is not a call to ignore reality. We need to face reality; we shouldn't ignore it. But then we must claim the promise of God and look through the eyes of faith. Don't be limited by human perception or ability. Let God give you spiritual perception. 1. Bring your situation to God. 2. Evaluate it in light of God's promise. 3. Look through the eyes of faith.

Easy Deviled Eggs

Put cooked egg yolks in a zip-lock bag. Seal the bag and mash till they are all broken up. Add remainder of ingredients, reseal. Keep mashing it up, mixing thoroughly. Cut the tip of the baggy, and squeeze the mixture into the egg. Then simply throw bag away when done—easy clean up.

Expanding Frosting

When you buy a container of cake frosting from the store, whip it with your mixer for a few minutes. You can double it in size. You get to frost more cake/cupcakes with the same amount. You also eat less sugar / fewer calories per serving.
