Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "What Comes Down is Going Back Up" using the scriptures II Cor. 3:17, I Peter 3:17-19 | 55:6-13 as his text. God knows and Eph. 4:7. Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. God is in the business of setting people free. But the Spirit of the Lord does not indiscriminately free all persons regardless of the condition of one's heart and whether he believes in and loves God or disbelieves and/or hates the Lord. The presence of the Lord is a discerning Spirit, bringing life & freedom to some while also bringing judgment upon others. Death is not the end of a human being. The Bible defines death as "the body without the spirit." After death, only the body is dead: the eternal essence of a human (soul) is preserved by God, and the spark of life (spirit/breath from God that causes life) returns to God who first gave it. Jesus taught about the (pre-Calvary) abode of the dead (Hell) | obedient to God's Spirit. If in the account of the rich man and Lazarus. It was a place divided into two compartments, one for the wicked dead (torment), and another for the righteous dead (comfort). After Jesus' death, He went to Hell, preached, and then led out those who were His. Ever since, the departed (dead) go either down to Hell (if wicked) or above to Paradise (if pleasing in God's sight). Men are to be judged according to their deeds done while on earth (in this life). TORMENT IS FOREVER! But there is still hope of salvation for all who are still breathing.

Pastor Joseph preached "Let It Pour" using Isaiah 46:9-13 and everything. He said, "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts" (Isa. 55:9). God told Solomon to ask what I shall give thee. Solomon asked for wisdom. He didn't want anything for himself; he just wanted to please God. If we want to please God, we will do what God wants us to do. Man ought to say, "I don't know everything, but I know One who does." The Spirit that leads us to repent and be baptized also will lead us to change our ways. Man can have a wonderful life if he is your life gets in a maze and you don't know which way to go, call upon God and He will show you the right way. God sends His Word to us like rain falling on parched ground. God's Spirit breathes down like rain and like snow. Get out in God's word and say "let it pour." Pastor Joseph preached "God's Unorthodox Method" using John 9:1-7 as his main text. Jesus spat on the ground, made clay, then put it in a man's eyes, and he was healed. The Pharisees didn't even care that the man could see, but rather chose to criticize about how it happened. Jesus made a practice of choosing the totally unorthodox way of doing something. All of us would have chosen some nice ointment, but Jesus used spit. "Religious" people may look down at those that desire and follow the whole truth. But what is reasonable to God is unreasonable to the world. and what is so very reasonable to the world is unreasonable to God. We ought to praise God no matter what others think. Some people (and some orthodox churches) come to God wanting His gifts. vet they want to live and dress the way the world does. We should live for God all the way, not part way. Many people want to live in the main stream. Let it go. It is wrong: it's not holy. Hold to the truth— God's Word!
