

Services! The special services with our guest speaker Rev. Earl Rodeheaver, Pastor in Kingsport, TN, have concluded, but our revival spirit continues on. Bro Rodeheaver's last message was entitled "Launch Out A Little Deeper" using Luke 5: 1-10 and Psalm 42:7. Just as Jesus told the fishermen (who had toiled all night and caught nothing) to launch out a little deeper, He is telling us today that we need to launch out a little deeper. Shake ourselves!
