We're all afraid of
something. God does
not intend for us to be
afraid because we are
more valuable than the
sparrows. God does not
want us to walk in fear
because it can keep us
from God's power.
God wants us to fear
Him and go beyond
that to reverence Him.
Are you afraid Jesus is
going to come back
and you aren't going to
be ready? This may be a good fear. But in
general, we need to let
fear be afraid of us.
Live today as if this is
your only day to serve
God. We have the
power, strength and
ability to overcome all
of our fears. "For God
hath not given us the
spirit of fear; but of
power, and of love, and
of a sound mind."
What is stopping you
from getting close to
God? Don't blame the
devil for everything.
The love of God will
get you through your
worst fears.

**Sunday PM** Pastor Joseph preached using John 7:37-39. Jesus said "If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water." Jesus wasn't talking about a little drip or tiny flow. He was talking about a river that will never run dry. The river of living water is the Holy Ghost. When that river starts to flow, things are going to happen. When Jesus was facing the cross, He prayed "Father, let this cup pass from me." But He brought His will under subjection and prayed "Not my will, but Thine be done." Now, we can have a well of living water springing up within our soul. 1 Peter 1:8 says it is "joy unspeakable and full of glory" Romans 14:17 says, "For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost." Jesus offers you to come and drink from the river of living water. You will

never thirst again!

#### **Wednesday PM**

Pastor Joseph preached about a proper relationship between Spirit-filled believers and human government. In Genesis 9:1-6. God commanded the entire human family to use capital punishment for the sin of murder. There the Lord revealed that the reason why murder is so very serious is because man was made in the image of God. According to Romans 13:1-4, the New Testament does not overturn God's command for capital punishment, but rather supports it. Some people think that hate is the only motive behind anyone supporting capital punishment. But such do not consider that the fear of God and reverence for His Word are genuine motives for supporting it. Sincere obedience to God leads to healthy respect for human government, which, according to the Bible, is ordained of God, and is supposed to be a "terror" to evil men, because of having the authority to dispense capital punishment. Each of us should "Study to shew thyself approved unto God. a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15).

Here are some pics of Randy Moore (nephew of Brother David Moore) for whom we have been praying. He is the "big" man in the right in the first two photos.







Details were very hard to come by at first, and we have learned more over time. He was not driving in a vehicle as was first reported. He stepped on the mine while walking on foot. It was known, and he stopped (the mine does not go off until you step away). It is said he would not be alive today if it were not for his lieutenant, which told him which way to face, and helped yank him as far away from the mine as possible. The lieutenant is now in the hospital.

Randy Moore has a badly fractured back, and stands a 50% chance of losing an arm, and a 60% chance of losing a leg.

He has been moved to the USA, and is currently at a medical facility at Fort Hood (an Army base in Texas).
