Sunday AM, May 18 This service was on Mother's Day. Elder David Harris Jr. preached "In The Mother's Lap" with his text coming from Gen. 3:20, Exodus 2:1-9, II Kings 4:15-30, Matthew 1:18, and I Timothy 1:5. Genesis 3:20 says, "And Adam called his wife's name Eve: because she was the mother of all living." A godly mother can perceive things from God, and do what a good mother does. In II Kings 4:15-30, at the beginning the Shunammite woman was not a mother, but she became one after the man of God gave her a word. Then later, her motherly instincts came into play when her son died. She went to find the man of God and he raised her son from the dead. Via our godly mothers we receive great things from
