#### Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached a message entitled "Prophet Margin" using Mark 8:36 for his text. In this verse Jesus said, "For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" Working for money is a fact of life, but it pales in comparison to working for the Lord with eternity in view. If you focus only on making money, then even if you succeed, you will have sold yourself short! Jesus said (within the same context), "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it." Thirty-one years ago the high school system in Shreveport, Louisiana (our pastor's hometown) was broken, yet tolerated. Schools suffered from unmotivated teachers, low morale, poor academics, and the typical undercurrent of student partying, drugs, alcohol, sinful sex, bullying and manipulation. And while such things may have persisted in some parts of the parish, a precious woman named Ascension Smith made sure there was at least one school that was different. She was the first principal of Caddo Magnet, now one of the best high schools in the nation, as recognized by US News and World Report. Don't waste your life just trying to get money and stuff. Determine to make each endeavor of your life an effort to truly serve the Lord by serving other people. Be servant minded, with a foot-washing "heartitude." Make a difference! T.F.
