
Last Sunday AM Elder Keith Fought preached "By Faith" using Hebrews 11:1-3. I don't "have" to go to church. I want to go to church! By faith we can receive what we need from God. You can't awake Sunday morning and just roll over and go back to sleep. You must get up and go to the house of God. Faith alone won't save you. It takes works also. Have faith that God will deliver you from any addiction that defiles this body. Without faith it is impossible to please God. Pleasing God must be the first and foremost thing in our life above all others. We must teach our children to pray and love God. By faith we know that God will protect them. By faith we must believe that Jesus is coming back after His church. By faith we must live a holy life and be ready when He comes. We've never seen Jesus, but we've got Him in our hearts. We can feel Him. We must serve Him by faith. Each morning start your day with prayer. Pray by faith that God will protect you this day. By faith God will make it happen. The woman with the issue of blood just touched the hem of His garment by faith and received a healing. Just believe. All things are possible by faith.

Sunday PM Pastor Joseph preached "Buried With Christ" using Romans 6:4. Paul the apostle foresaw a time when we will "ever be with the Lord" (1 Thess. 4:17). So he wrote, "I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better: Nevertheless to abide in the flesh is more needful for you" (Phil. 1:23-24). However, the fact is that we can be "with Christ" even while we're still abiding in the flesh. Paul himself emphasized this. Positionally, we are already "with Christ," because that's where God sees us and how He relates to us. He has "raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Eph. 2:6). Before we could be raised up with Christ, however, we first had to die with Him. "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; vet not I, but Christ liveth in me" (Gal. 2:20). God even sees us as buried with Christ when He was buried, and this is the great truth symbolized in our water baptism in Jesus name. "We are buried with him by baptism into death" (Rom. 6:4). This truth is an incentive for godly living.
