Last Sunday AM Elder Keith Fought preached "What God Calls Sacrifice. Abraham Called Worship" using Genesis 22:1-5. When God told Abraham to offer his only son, Isaac, as a sacrifice, he didn't question God. He just rose up early in the morning and went to the place where God had told him. God wanted to see how close Abraham was to Him. He knew what he could go through. Abraham and his son went up to worship. Isaac looked at Abraham and asked him where the sacrifice was. Abraham replied that God will provide. Trust God! Just as he put forth his hand with a knife to kill his son. God provided a burnt sacrifice. When God tells you to do something, do it.
