Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Experience the Power of Pentecost" using Joel 2:21-25, 28-30 & Acts 2:1-4. Joel, a minor prophet, prophesied in advance about the outpouring of the Holy Ghost that happened on the Day of Pentecost, recorded in Acts chapter 2. What happened to the first church is still happening today. People are being filled with the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking with other tongues and being baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. We need to contend for this faith-this Pentecost experience. This is not a myth; this is not a legend. Being filled with God's Spirit is real. There are two components to the new birth experience: being born of water (water baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ) and being born of of spirit (baptism of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues). Repentance and water baptized are both "for the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38). Being baptized with the Holy Ghost is even better than being baptized with water. When you receive the Holy Ghost, you are receiving "Holy God." Both water and Spirit are essential. God is pouring out His Spirit on all flesh—people from every ethnicity. The promise is to all young, old, rich or poor, bond or free. This is a powerful experience that is needed by all men! It is God's will that all believers should received the Spirit!

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached using II Timothy 2:14-26, 3:1-9; Numbers 20:1-8, and Micah 6:8, 7:8. We are living in dark hours. The Bible, prayer and the ten commandments have been taken out of our schools. Children are turning against parents; husbands against wives. People have a form of godliness but they don't love God. We who are born again must stand on God's truth. Study God's Word; pray. Be careful where you look for bonding and emotional intimacy. The devil is baiting us to do something wrong, for then he would have us in his clutches. Husbands and wives, pray about every decision you make in your marriage. Be careful to not let bad people/spirits creep in. Let God's Spirit lead you.

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached "Lessons Learned from Noble Romans" using Matthew 8:1-13. A Roman centurion came unto Jesus, asking the Lord to heal his servant. Jesus offered to go to his house, but the centurion said that he was not worthy for Jesus to come to his house. He showed that a trip was not needed; because he was a man under authority, he knew that he told his people what to do and they did it. Jesus had not found such faith in all Israel. This Roman was a humble man. He knew Jesus had power. He didn't send his servants to Jesus; he came himself. Like this Roman, we ought to recognize our place. Be careful. Don't lash out whenever you are frustrated. Be angry and sin not. God is working on each one of us to make us who we ought to be. When you're sick, don't assume people know. Make the call to ask for prayer. Don't skip church without a valid reason. If you do, and no one calls you very soon, then reach out for help.
