Sunday PM


Elder David Harris Jr. preached "Grab The Devil By The Tail" using Song of Solomon 2:15. We need to catch the little foxes who try to creep in and spoil the vine or destroy our walk with God. Destroy everything the devil brings your way. Foxes work only in the night. That's why we need God's light and to have His Word hidden in our hearts. Spirits will come and try to keep us from living a holy, consecrated life for God. They'll tell us that we are "living too holy" or we "go to church too much." Ungodly men will preach words that tickle our ears. We need to catch those foxes and destroy them. We need to stand firm upon God's Word. His Word never changes. Believe what the Bible says and stand upon what you believe. Beware of what tries to attach itself to your thinking and to your soul. God is letting His light shine through us to keep the foxes away.

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached on "True Freedom" using John 8:31-36, Matthew 7:15-23 & Hebrews 10:19-20. A disciple of Jesus obeys the Word of God, continuing in its teachings. In John 8 and Matthew 7, Jesus addressed people who were not free, yet they thought they were. True freedom is not a lack of restraint from doing evil; it is being liberated from one's own carnal nature so one can do right. We have a promise that if we continue in God's word then we will be free. When someone is truly free, he yearns for righteousness. The genuine fruit of the Spirit cannot be faked. There are not multiple "fruits of the Spirit." There is only one fruit, with many attributes. People try to fake some of the attributes and comfort themselves by claiming to have "some of the fruits of the Spirit." One cannot have all of the attributes unless he truly has the Spirit helping. Your sin will find you out. According to Matthew 7, not everyone who professes to be a Christian is going to Heaven. Many who claim Him as Lord will be lost. Continue in God's word—obey and don't get sidetracked. What direction are you headed? Let us come to God with our failures and shortcomings and allow Him to change us.
