Come to Him with all your sins, weaknesses, and addictions and ask for His forgiveness. He will forgive you and change you. If you won't repent, if you refuse to change, then the judgment of God will abide on you. If you do repent, the mercy of God will abide on you. He is forever merciful to those who will come to Him and repent. Although He is a God of love and mercy, He is also a God of judgment. He will pour His wrath out on those who continue in their sin and will not repent. Abstain from sexual sin. God's Word stresses to us to not fornicate. The word fornication refers to any and all types of sexual sin. If you do fornicate, you are sinning against your own body. The Bible teaches that we should dress modestly, and the reason is because of the tie between immodesty and fornication, for the Bible stresses much more to not fornicate. Dressing modestly is a guard rail to prevent lust which can lead to fornication. There also other guard rails we should all have in our lives. An addiction is anything that has power over you. We must rid ourselves of all sinful addictions, such as sex outside of marriage, alcohol, tobacco, pornography; even anger can be an addiction. If you're in the wrong, repent. Let us serve the Lord in freedom!

1. What did Jesus do before he chose the 12?


