Pastor Joseph preached "I'm Going Through" using the 13th chapter of Hebrews for his text. *Amen* means "so be it." All the promises of God in Him are Yea and Amen! Sin-cursed human beings are often plagued by an inability to accept Yes for an answer. All the promises God has made to us do indeed call for a response: AMEN! Take a step of faith to demonstrate you are saying Yes to healing, to salvation, to healthy emotions and bodies, to blessings both spiritual and temporal. 
