Sunday AM - Annual Sunday School Picnic - all day at the park

Our Sunday School picnic was held at Veterans Park. It was wonderful to raise our hands and praise God and to hear the preaching of God's Word in an open-air shelter. Pastor Joseph preached "Community of the Called-Out Ones" from Galatians 3:1-6. We are saved by grace through faith, but faith without works is dead. We must have obedient faith. We must live with good works even as Noah had good works and built the ark when God told him it was going to rain. We must do through faith what Jesus tells us to do. In Revelation seven golden candlesticks typified the seven churches of Asia minor. The angel of each church was the pastor. Jesus was in the midst of the candlesticks. The oil in the candlesticks is symbolic of the Lord's Holy Spirit in the churches' members. God commanded the Old Testament saints to slay a lamb as a sin offering to God. This was a shadow of Jesus on the cross. Jesus shed His blood and made a way for each of us to obtain salvation. He has commanded us to repent, be baptized, be filled with the Holy Ghost, and to live a holy life. Just as it was essential for the Old Testament saints to slay an animal, it is essential for us now to be obedient to Jesus. If we are saved, we will have obedient faith. We will do good works. We will dress, talk, walk, and act holy. True believers are obedient. If we draw closer to Jesus, we will draw closer to one another. We will help one another. We will have love in our hearts for our brothers and sisters. The church will have unity. *Unity brings revival*.

Pastor Joseph preached "Pray Until..." from Acts 4:15-31. We need to pray until the place where we are is shaken. We don't pray in effort to change God's mind; He already wants to help us. Instead pray until you get your carnal nature out of the way and your own mind is changed by God's power. Pray until you lay aside bitterness against people so you can forgive them. Pray until you get your flesh under subjection to God's will. Pray until you pray through. To pray is to "ask," but it means more too, when it comes to asking God for a need. It not to just to ask, but also to praise and worship God. I Thess. 5:16-18 says (in part), "Rejoice evermore." No matter what you go through, have a heart of rejoicing. Have an inward mindset of praise and prayer on both good days and bad days. You can be frustrated and still have praise in your heart. "In every thing give praise." You must rise above the drama in life and be a special person unto the Lord. He has called you out of this world to be a holy and sanctified person. A called-out person has a prayerful mindset. Pray effectual prayers, not just vain prayers. Pray in the Spirit on all occasions (Eph. 6:18), no matter where you may be. Get your carnal nature out of the way and pray in the Spirit. Forget about who might hear you speak in tongues and let God have His way. Pray until your place is shaken.



Fun! Kids Corner Obey God's Word – II Kings 22, 23


