Pastor Joseph preached "The Signs" from Mark 16:14-18. Every step in salvation is a gift from God. Baptism is for believers. God is not willing that any should perish. Jesus is both God and man. God gave Christ Jesus (the man) all power and authority. When we receive the Holy Ghost, we receive power (Acts 1:8). The Church is sent forth by the Lord Jesus and has the authority represent the sender in name, power, and authority. This is why we "shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover." All we have to do is call on the name of Jesus to receive. "And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents [accidentally]; and if they drink any deadly thing [accidentally], it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." Salvation is the greatest of all miracles. God wants to heal our heart and give us the Holy Ghost. "If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water" (John 7:37-38).

Pastor Joseph preached "For the Praise of His Glory" from Isaiah 60:18-19; 61:1-3, 8-11. What a difference Jesus makes! A person may be so bound by sin that "if it's wrong, he'll do it." Then he can be touched by God and find grace and mercy. When the man bound by devils saw Jesus coming, he ran to Him and worshipped. Jesus had compassion for him. When we get around Jesus, He's going to show us love, mercy and compassion. The Spirit of God anointed Jesus to be the Saviour. He will give us beauty (in exchange) for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning and the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. We ought to praise His great glory!


Wednesday
