#### **Sunday AM**

Pastor Joseph preached "Just One Misstep" from Philippians 3:9-14. The question is not "will I make a misstep?" The question is "how will I respond to that misstep?" When you do spiritually fall down, press or reach out to Jesus as He wonderfully reached out for you. Your heart is wicked: it will trick you. Don't follow your heart; follow Jesus. The enemy and people will lie to you. Stay focused on Jesus. He Word is a lamp unto your feet and a light unto your path. Listen to God's Word. Stay strong in God's Spirit. No man can serve two masters. If you please the world, you won't please God. Beware of the principles of the world. We don't need what the world has to offer. We have everything in Jesus. We are complete in Him. Forget the past and reach forward to Jesus. In our Christian walk, our unmovable landmark is Jesus. Don't take your eyes off Jesus.

#### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "All Things" from Philippians 4:6-9, 11-13. Don't worry about anything. Pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for what He has done. You should continually be thinking about good things. God's peace will then be with you. Be content no matter in what state you find yourself. Apostle Paul said he knew how to be humbled and to prosper. In every situation he learned the secret of being full and of going hungry, of having too much and of having too little. He said he could do all things through Christ who strengthened him. Life is a roller coaster of ups and downs but you can have peace of mind through it all. Live your life with your mind made up that you're going to make it with Jesus. Be faithful to church, living right, giving, witnessing. When you're stressed and feel like you're going to lose your mind, keep living for God.

### Wednesday

Elder Hannah Sandy preached about the three fathers we have in our life: our familial father (whether biological or adoptive), our pastor, and God. There will be times when submitting to godly father figures is challenging and may seem unsavory, but it is wise to honor them and obey them. There is a great blessing in doing so. A good father, or father figure, is a blessing from God. Pastor Joseph delivered a pro-life appeal, using I John 1:1-3 as his text. God's Word (which in Greek is Logos, meaning thought, plan, or intent) is not separable from God, and Jesus Christ is God's Logos (plan) made flesh (as a man). See John 1:1,14. In I John, the same writer described God's plan this way: "the word of life." God is a God of life. His is a plan of life. He creates life, sustains life, and loves life. Thus, anyone who truly knows God and is filled with God's Spirit will be pro-life. The terrible lies, by which our society has been seduced into the wickedness of abortion, have produced today's culture of death. We, as God's ambassadors, must use our voices, our votes, and our vitality to spread the truth and turn our society away from the terrible injustice of abortion, which has killed some 57 million babies since 1973, in the US alone. God help us overturn Roe!


