Elder Lorren Godwin preached from II Timothy 1:7, emphasizing that we do not need to fear the devil. Being afraid is not of God. "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind." Satan is a fallen angel. Do not fear him, for he has no authority. (His greatest weapon is his lying voice. He is skilled in deception.) Jesus has all power in Heaven and in earth. We need to have a mindset of "I will not fear the devil." Satan couldn't attack Job until God gave him permission. We need to be strong in the Lord so we'll be able to stand against the wiles (devious or cunning stratagems) of the devil. The devil is a trickster, a deceiver, a spirit whose imagined power is hugely exaggerated. He comes against us with lies or temptations. It's then that we must call upon God. The Lord is our help in time of trouble. "When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him" (Isaiah 59:19). We have no reason to fear. Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world.

Elder Zach Sandy preached from Mark 2:1-4. Four men carrying a man who was paralyzed came to see Jesus. When they realized they couldn't get near Him because of the crowd, they improvised a plan to go through the roof. Whatever you have to do to get to Jesus, do it. Elder Sandy told of how his weakness was a witnessing tool. We get so focused on what's going on in our lives that we don't stop to witness and help others. People are watching us to see how we react to a situation. Does God get the glory? We need to use our trials and tests to help others. With God's help we can do all things.

Elder Baron Claypool preached about the importance of God's Word from I Kings 8:1-11 & Nehemiah 8:1-4. God's Word (the Bible) needs to be the most important possession that we have. It is not just a bunch of Sunday School stories. It is God speaking to us. We need to find time for God to speak to us through His Word. His Word will give us encouragement, wisdom, guidance; it is a Lamp unto our feet and a Light unto our path. It will tell us exactly where we stand in God. "For thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name" (Psalm 138:2). How precious the name of Jesus is to us! God's Word is magnified above the name of Jesus. Study God's Word; engraft it upon the tables of your heart.







Continue to pray, and continue to call both the WV State Senate and the House of Delegates!

The Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act is almost past all hurdles! We've come too far to give up now!

It is our understanding that today is the last day for the legislature to meet for this year's legislation business. The bill has passed the WV Senate Judiciary Committee with one tolerable amendment. It then went back to the House to be sure they concurred with the Senate amendment, and then it would come back to the Senate for a third and final reading and a vote. As of late last night, the bill was still sitting in the House waiting for their action. Contact the office of Tim Miley, who presides over the House, and tell him *"Vote FOR the version of the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act, HB 4588, which came out of the Senate Judiciary Committee on Thursday."* Also, call our Senators who represent Harrison County and tell them to vote for the bill on the final reading!

Below is an email sent in the wee hours from Linda Oldack, our Harrison County chapter president for West Virginians for Life:

"It is actually 12:23 am Sunday morning. I have not received word that the bill was voted out of the House with the Senate changes. The bill then has to go back to the Senate for a final reading and vote. That would be tomorrow at Noon, if it did indeed pass the House tonight. I can only hope that I have not heard anything because our lobbyist did not have a chance yet to inform of the passage. Hoping that it is not still laying there on someone's desk. Thank you all for your prayers and calls. Will report as soon as I am sent anything. Tired, going to bed.
