Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson about faithfulness and love, titled, "All For One and One For All" from Matthew 24:45-47 and Proverbs 6:16-19, 18:24 & 17:17. We must show love and loyalty to each other. The people of Israel chose to disobey God. They rejected God's promised land, which would correspond to a modernday person rejecting God's promised baptism of His Spirit. The people murmured, complained and blamed their leader, Moses. God threatened to destroy them, but Moses pleaded to God to not wipe them out. He loved God and he loved God's people. God consented, but He had them wander in the wilderness until they died. Moses, Aaron, Joshua, and Caleb displayed great loyalty and love by suffering with the doubters for 40 years! We are not fighting against flesh and blood. We're fighting against spiritual wickedness (spirits). Be loyal to your church and to your pastor. Don't make a mess and sow discord. If you do wrong, stay and make it right. You have to pray for yourself and make up your own mind to be loyal!

Pastor Joseph preached about faith versus doubt from John 18:25-27 & 21:15-17. If you believe that the Gospel is the Death, Burial and Resurrection of Jesus then you will repent, be baptized in Jesus name and be filled with the Holy Ghost. If you don't believe, you are likened to the people of Israel who rejected the promise of God. Thus, they wandered 40 years in the wilderness and died and never got to enter the promised land. Just as the spies from Israel explored the promised land for 40 days, Jesus was seen and talked with His apostles 40 days after His resurrection. He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which is the Holy Ghost. We must have the Holy Ghost, the power from above. Don't reject this commandment of God if you want to enter into the promised land, Heaven. Before Calvary, Peter denied Jesus thrice. After Calvary Jesus gave Peter three chances to say "I Love You." There's victory in Calvary!

Elder Hannah Sandy preached from I Peter 2:9. We are a chosen generation. We were made to walk and talk as God's people. We should never be ashamed about the way we live. 
