Pastor Joseph taught part 2 of the series on "How New Testament Believers Should Apply the Mosaic Law"—not by joining ourselves unto the Mosaic Covenant, which is neither allowable nor even possible, but by discerning principles that God revealed in the Old Testament narrative, and filtering those principles through the New Testament writings, and finally applying them in our current situation. Every prior dispensation/covenant has involved the selfrevelation of God unto mankind, and even though we cannot go back in time and place ourselves into those covenants, we can and should study them in the Bible and learn about God, which better informs our obedience in our own current covenant, the New Covenant. The goal and purpose of every one of the covenants has been the salvation of mankind, through a genuine relationship with God and each other.

Rev. Matt Runyon preached about salvation from Hebrews 9:1-5. God gave very specific instructions to the Israelites about how to construct the tabernacle and all the furniture in it, including the Ark of the Covenant. Scripture tells us the earthly tabernacle was designed after the pattern of the heavenly tabernacle. The furniture in it symbolically relates to our salvation. The items inside the Ark of the Covenant are symbols for us. The bowl of manna symbolizes God providing for us. Aaron's rod that budded represents the resurrection of Jesus and represents authority in the life of the believer and the authority of the man of God. The tables of stone represent the truth of God's word. We must be diligent to follow God's word in our daily lives to avail ourselves of His salvation.

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Your Latter Will Be Greater" from Job 42:12. We all know the story of Job: he lost everything that he had, and yet he still praised God. God blessed the latter end of job more than the beginning. You have some things that need your attention in order to receive the blessings of God. 
