In the time of the Old Testament, the blood of bulls and goats did not pay for eternal salvation, but rather served to foreshadow the blood of Jesus, which is the perfected reality that those symbolic sacrifices pointed to. When we are truly born again and have His blood applied to our lives, it makes us of one heart with all other true believers. One evidence that this unity is present is when we care for each other and make sure that none of us suffers lack. Thank God for the blood, and for this wonderful church which was bought by His blood!




Fun! Kids Corner Joseph Goes To Egypt
