Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught a "Rapture/End-Time" study from I Thessalonians 4:1-18, about the "Day of the Lord" (Hebrew: Yom Yahweh), which is a phrase referring to any time period (and not necessarily a 24-hour day) when God moves in strong judgment against wickedness. At the end of this current age, the Great Tribulation will be yet another Yom Yahweh. Two examples of prior ones include the global flood in the time of Noah, and the fire from heaven upon Sodom and Gomorrah. From these examples, we see clear precedents in which God rescues His people beforehand to prevent them from suffering with the wicked. This forms part of the basis for believing the Rapture of the Church will be before the Tribulation. Noah preached to people, but they did not repent. God saved Noah and his family from the destruction of the world. Lot preached to the people of Sodom and Gomorrah, but they wouldn't listen. God took Lot and his family out before His fury fell upon the cities. Jesus is going to come as a thief in the night. Those who have repented, been baptized in Jesus' name, and received the Holy Ghost—and are living a holy life—will be changed and caught up to meet Him in the air. We will be at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb. Jesus will come as KING OF KINGS and LORD OF LORDS and execute judgment upon those who have not obeyed His gospel.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Let Her Alone" from Matthew 26:6-13, Mark 14:3-9, & John 12:1-8. The woman who poured precious ointment on Jesus was doing this for His burial. This was her way of worship. Worship is every part of our life—not just praise at church. It is everything we are. Some people want to put on a show to attract others to themselves, but our worshipful praise should be for God. A true worshipper will worship Him in Spirit and in truth. We should care more about what God thinks of us than what people think. We worship God in the way we dress and adorn ourselves, in our speech, and in every aspect of our life. We can also minister to others by our praise. Sometimes we may feel pressured and let up on our praise. We ought not, because someone who is hurting may need the Lord's anointing via our praise. Even when you don't feel like it, keep praising Him and doing what's right. Don't criticize or minimize someone's sincere worship of God!

Wednesday

Elder Les Benedum preached from II Chronicles 7:14-15. If we want God to hear us when we call upon Him, and to forgive our sins and heal our land, then we must humble ourselves. We must pray; not because we are forced to, but because we have a desire to please God. Seek God's face, that is, seek His direction in your life. Let us be humble enough to say "No" to sin. If we are humble, we will walk and talk like Christians. We must not be too proud to knock on someone's door and invite them to church. When someone new comes to church, greet them, shake their hand, and tell them that you're glad they came. Humble yourselves before the face of God.
