Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Be a Reflection of Jesus Christ" from Psalm 19:14. When the world sees us, they should see Jesus. What are we saying with our lifestyle and words? We need to stay full of the Holy Ghost. We, as the church, have a job to tell others about Jesus. We need to let people know that Jesus loves them. They are looking for what we have found. Don't hide what Jesus gave you. We find time to do what we want to do. We need to take time for God. We influence people by our everyday lifestyle. We need to stand on God's Word. What consumes our thoughts? Let our every thought come into the obedience of Jesus. We must be a reflection of Jesus at all times. Pastor Joseph preached "Earth Shattering Praise!" from Isaiah 60:18 & 61:1-3. 
