Just as the sacrifice had to be completely consumed in the old covenant, Jesus had to die. It wasn't enough for Him to be beaten. "Without shedding of blood is no remission" of sins (Hebrews 9:22). Jesus is our Passover Lamb. We are redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ. We must be complete in Him and get everything God has for us. We must be baptized in Jesus' name and have the Holy Ghost and live a lifestyle free from sin.


