Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught "Shepherd Stages, Part 1: Cycles of Life in the Kingdom of God" from Matthew 24:45-51 & 20:25-28. The Greek word translated as "pastor" means "shepherd." The Greek word as "elder" usually refers to someone senior in age and experience. When we are born again, we are spiritual infants. Like natural infants, we often lack maturity and need care and nourishment from the church, our spiritual mother, including from our pastor and elders, but also from mature saints as well. The newborn Christian's strongest bond is with the **church**. As we mature, we go from being served to serving others—from needing care to giving care. This is what true leadership in the Kingdom of God is: serving others. We must remain faithful and walk in truth. Our inheritance from God belongs to the faithful. The goal of Kingdom authority is to see growth in others. Then as the sheep mature in Christ, they will care for other newborn sheep. Even as Jesus came to serve others, we must be willing to be a servant. We must be soul winners.

Sunday PM

God moved in an awesome, powerful way. Pastor Joseph preached from II Corinthians 2:11. Beware: do not be ignorant of Satan's devices. Among his most successful devices is sowing discord and planting bitterness. Church discipline is biblical and is intended to benefit a disciplined individual as well as the church. When a brother is overtaken in a fault, go to him in love. After he is disciplined, forgive. Then we should show love, assuming a repented one stays faithful and is still present to be loved. When one repents, God forgives him of his past. It is all under the blood of Jesus. It is wrong to reach under the blood of Jesus to bring up the past. We must also forgive ourselves and not let the past have power over us.

Wednesday

Elder Zach Sandy preached "Jesus Is Not Afraid Of The Storm" from Matthew 8:23-27. There is nothing impossible for Jesus to do. He can calm any storm. You may feel like there's no way possible, but just one word from Jesus clears the way. If you have the Holy Ghost, you have the same power to speak to the storm and it has to cease. Speak to sickness in your body and it has to flee. The storm that you are in right now is an opportunity for a miracle. Don't be afraid. Jesus is in control.


Friday
