Last Sunday AM (Resurrection Sunday, a.k.a. Easter)

Pastor Joseph preached from Mark 11:20-26. Jesus was the ultimate sacrifice who paid the total penalty for our sins. He was buried and resurrected from the dead. Jesus bought our salvation through His death, burial and resurrection. He purchased us (redeemed us) with His own blood and made salvation available to all who obey Him. We must all partake of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. To repent is to die out to sin, meaning to turn your life around. After repenting, new believers are to be figuratively buried with Jesus by being water baptized in Jesus name. Through receiving the Holy Ghost, ideally as we rise from the waters of baptism, we figuratively experience the resurrection. Through the New Birth experience, we can have a new life without sin. Jesus died once so that we can be born twice. When we were born the first time we were born with a sin curse. We must be born again. We must be born of water (water baptism) and born of the Spirit (Holy Ghost). We must have a transformation of character. There must be a spiritual transformation of our mind/spirit. The transformation of the body does not happen until after the rapture. Until then a struggle exists between the old self and the new man. Choose to ignore carnal wants. Stay consecrated to God. Have daily prayer & Bible study. Crucify the deeds of our flesh, every single day. We must live an overcoming life and not allow sin to dominate our lives.






