#### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Christ Our Passover" from I Corinthians 11:17-34. The Jewish Passover lamb, without spot or blemish, foreshadowed the better and final Passover Lamb, Jesus Christ. Through His sinless life and sacrificial death, Jesus became the only One capable of giving us a way to escape eternal judgment and a sure hope of eternal life. Jesus is "without blemish"—completely free from sin. We are to memorialize His death when we partake of the Lord's Supper. During the time of the Mosaic Covenant, a Gentile (non-Israelite) could obtain salvation by gaining Israeli citizenship, and from then on eating only clean meats. The concept of clean and unclean animals is symbolic of clean (saved) people and unclean (unsaved) people. By contrast, during the New Covenant age, an "unclean" Gentile can become saved (clean) without having to become Jewish, which is symbolically like adding an unclean animal to the "clean meats" list. God actually does this for Gentile believers in Jesus when we receive our food with prayer and thanksgiving, and thus at every meal we see a symbol of our salvation in the foods we eat.

#### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Mount" from Hebrews 12:18-29 & Exodus 19:1-14, 20-25. Moses set boundaries at Mt. Sinai for his people. We need to set boundaries in our lives, which should be <u>far</u> from the world. Set them far from the mountain of death so you will not be in danger of being destroyed. The Lord is a consuming fire! God's voice was so terrifying and awesome to the people that they didn't want to hear it. Yet we need the voice of God in our lives. When sin does abound, the voice of God will be so terrifying to us that we will repent. God is too holy for us to enter His presence full of sin. This is the contrast between "believing" without obedience and actually obeying the gospel. It is when you obey the gospel through repentance, water baptism and receiving the Holy Ghost that you don't come to the mountain of death but to the mountain of Zion. We must live holy and set apart from this world. We need to think about all we do with eternity in view!

#### Wednesday






