Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Stones From the Brook" from I Samuel 17:38-40. David had practiced with his sling, and considered it tested and proved. David knew that with God's help, the sling was an effective weapon. He felt foolish with the king's armor & weapons, which he had not proved. So instead, he took the familiar – a sling and five stones from the brook. The devil is doing all he can to destroy us. It is time for us to fight back. David found his projectiles to defeat the giant in a brook—the lowest part of the valley. Our low point is where we find the ammunition to defeat our giants. Don't let the devil intimidate you. "...Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world" (I John 4:4). We can know that God is in control even in the worst time in our lives. We will come out on the winning side with the God we serve. Use your prayer life as a tool to defeat the devil.

Evangelist Carlton Clark preached "Can You Stand To Be Blessed?" from I Kings 3:5-15. Because Solomon asked God for wisdom and an understanding heart, God granted him wisdom, riches and honor. He was a blessed man. But Solomon loved many strange women and began to worship pagan gods. Thus, he lost it all. He actually could not stand to be blessed. He came to the conclusion that "all is vanity" (Ecclesiastes 1:2). We must use our blessings to minister in the service of the Lord. *Can you stand to be blessed?* We often take our blessings for granted and call our walk an Apostolic lifestyle. The poorest of us live in splendor unheard of in the days of Solomon. We need to surrender our lives to God. Don't be haughty when God blesses us, but desire to be used of the Lord. People who try us may be a test of our blessing. They may be poking us to see if we are truly serving God. Can you be blessed and, still, obey the commandments of the Lord?




