#### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "A Soft Answer" from Psalm 15:1. Israel was still burning at the time, though most of the fires were finally under control. Much of it was arson—anti-Israel terrorism. We are to pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Ps. 122:6). That means desiring peace for all sides of the conflict in Israel. Jesus commanded us to love even our enemies and to pray for them (Matt. 5:44). This is the answer for not only the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, but also for the horrific racial tensions and class warfare we're suffering here in the USA. There is a powerful wisdom in Psalm 15:1: "A soft answer turns away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger." Regardless which side you're on, please offer a soft answer instead of a harsh tone. We need healing now, not incitement. Please look over your social media wall, placing yourself in the shoes of those you oppose, and consider whether your tone seeks to promote more hatred instead of seeking to promote healing. We do need to take sides against evil and speak up, but do so with the proper tone. We must seek to propagate civility, not barbarism, even if we're faced with barbarism.

#### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Conclusion" from Ecclesiastes 12:9-14. This famous passage reads, in part, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil." Today, many unbelievers live as though they have no fear of God, and sadly many backsliders, who ought to know better, also live as though they will never answer to God for their actions. Their departure causes intense pain for God's heart, as well as for the pastor's heart. Paul the Apostle mentioned in his writings the great joy he got from knowing that the converts he had won were staying faithful and true, and indicated the pain their spiritual demise would cause him. We have to know that the same is true with God, even more so. The spiritual disciplines of living for God are not a mystery. Faithfulness to church, prayer, Bible reading, witnessing, giving/tithing, fasting, worship.... By these we can remain strong in our faith.

Jr. Elder JT Sandy preached "Taking The Air Out Of Your Fire" from Daniel 3:1-30. Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego were thrown into a burning fiery furnace for doing what God said. They told the king that they would not serve his gods nor bow down and worship the golden image. It's a blessing to be able to go to the house of God. We ought not take for granted the blessings that we have to obey God freely. Your trials and situations may seem like a fire burning all around you, but God can remove the air and put out your fires. Serve him faithfully!


