Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Decoy" from Psalm 23:1-6. God is with us at all times. When we are in the valley of discouragement, we may feel like God is far from us, but discouragement flourishes when our focus is on the situation around us instead of on God. The devil is always showing us things and trying to distract us. When life is good and we are being blessed, all of a sudden something shows up, and we lose focus. If we follow after that thing we get shipwrecked. We should not allow ourselves to be distracted and tricked and tempted to sin. Don't fall for the decoy! We have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Thus we have power over the devil and the ability to defeat him by just breathing the name of Jesus. Don't let anything separate you from the love of God (Romans 8:36-39).

There is a certain sense of fulfillment in one's life that can only be found in seeing a lost soul come to God. What's your focus? If your focus is on Jesus, then it will also be on soul-winning / witnessing. In Jesus dwells all the fullness of the deity. He has washed our sins away. We are complete in Him. Enjoy each day with your friend Jesus – spend time with Him in prayer and thanksgiving.


