#### Sunday AM

Evangelist Brian Norman preached "A Few Things Learned Along The Way" from Matthew 17:20. Look on the fields with faith. We need to *lift up our eyes* and see where God has brought us from and how He is blessing us. When we see people in bad situations and problems, we need to speak life unto them and encourage them. Speak life in situations and encourage somebody. Sometimes we get so focused on the problem that God can't help us. We see what's wrong and not what's right. Peter walked on the water until he looked at the winds and raging water. We need to *lift up our eyes* and see how God is blessing our lives. We need to recognize how God has been good to us. "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above" (James 1:17). Yes, God is good to us, but there needs to be instilled in our hearts a hunger to see lost souls won. We must love people even when they aren't good to us. Be kind and show love regardless of the circumstances. The reason people visit church the second time is because the people are friendly. Sow faithfully and with focus. Pray every day that we can be a blessing to others — that "rivers of living water" will flow from us (John 7).

Evangelist Brian Norman preached "Clay in the Hands of the Potter" from Genesis 27. God formed us out of the dust of the earth and breathed into us, thus we became a living soul. We weren't made for the world, but God made the world for us. He is the potter and we are the clay. Since the fall, we are born with a sin curse upon us so we have to choose to allow God to put us back on the wheel and shape us into an honorable vessel. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). We can't do anything of eternal value without God's help. We must decrease and let God increase. Lift up Jesus! We are just the clay in the Potter's hand. We have flaws and faults, and we make mistakes, but we must be willing to let Jesus put us back on the wheel and mold and make us into a vessel of honor. 


