Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on thankfulness titled, "When Life Is Not Fair," from I Thessalonians 5:18. There's a phrase in our vocabulary that we should ban in our households. It is "that's not fair." The concept itself dates back to the fall of man, when the serpent first sold Eve a like that God wasn't fair by not letting them eat of the fruit of the tree. Ingratitude lit the match of the original sin. Whatever wound you have suffered, God is still able to do great things for you. Sometimes God will allow you to go through painful situations because God knows that hurting people who have gotten the victory can be trusted not to hurt others. The antidote for "that's not fair" is "In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (I Thessalonians 5:18). This is the cure for ingratitude and an entitlement mentality. It's not God's will for us to go through bad situations, but to get rid of bad attitudes, trust Him and give thanks. Get your mind off of how you've been disadvantaged in life and focus on the good that God has given you. There's a victory if you give thanks in the midst of your storm.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on "Tithes And Offerings" from Malachi 3:10-12 and Luke 6:37-38. A tithe is one-tenth of all of one's "increase" (which includes monetary "income" but is also a broader term). God has commanded to bring all of the tithes into the storehouse. Even as Abraham gave one-tenth to Melchizedek, we ought also to give one-tenth of our increase unto the Lord. If we will bring our tithes with a right heart and a right attitude God will open the windows of Heaven and pour us out a blessing. All we have belongs to God, but when we give God back the tithe that was His to begin with, He blesses us abundantly, spiritually and physically. To give tithes and offerings is an expression of trusting God. Offerings are gifts brought to God that are beyond the tithes. If we give, God will give back to us. Conversely, if we do not give tithes and offerings, we are robbing God, and we lose God's blessing upon our productivity and finances, returning to a default state of being cursed. Let us trust God to do more with the remainder than we could have accomplished by keeping 100%. Trust God! "Give, and it shall be given you; pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again" (Luke 6:38).

Elder Caleb Colombo preached, "What's the Sling and Stone?" from I Samuel 17:20-51. David, just a ruddy youth, had faith when he went out to meet the giant, Goliath. He didn't need the king's armour. He just went in the name of the Lord. We must put on the whole armour of God when we go out to battle. Go out with praise in your heart knowing that God is going to fight the battle for you. Pastor Joseph taught a prophecy lesson from the Book of Joel.




