Pastor Joseph preached "Altar Builders" from Genesis 22:6-9. Abraham's willingness to build an altar to offer his son, Isaac, was a prophetic foretelling of something to come (Calvary). God provided a ram so Isaac would not be killed. However on the cross of Calvary, a natural altar, God allowed His own human manifestation, the Son of God, to be crucified. Abraham was willing to give his most treasured gift upon the altar by trusting that God could raise Isaac from the dead. Jesus rose from the dead after three days. Each one of us must build an altar. We need to be willing to lay down whatever it is that's dearest to us on that altar. If you surrender your all to God, you will receive it all back plus more than you can imagine. God only restores that which you give Him to hold onto. Don't ever refuse to build an altar and surrender your all to God. One should build their altar as an ornate thing to glorify self. Build your altar to be about sacrifice and what you are willing to give God. We are the temple of the Holy Ghost. We must worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness. God loves the worship that comes from a pure heart. No one will be greatly used of God until they build an altar. Sacrifice that which has great meaning to you. Give Him your all, and He will bless you!

Pastor Joseph preached "Our Champion" from Revelation 5:5. Our champion is King Jesus. He prevailed when as a man He died for us on Calvary. Jesus is the Lamb of God who took away the sin of the world. He knows what is best for us and is working all things for our good. Death is only a door through which we enter into Heaven with our champion, Jesus. We must have a made-up mind, a determination that when life isn't fair to us, we are going to serve God and be faithful to church. We aren't following fairness; we're following our champion. Jesus is our champion, and whenever He leads we are to follow Him. We need to be rooted and built up in Him. Jesus is the Anointed One and in Him dwelleth all the fulness of the Deity bodily. If you're suffering from a crisis in your life right now, take heart: Jesus is in the process of preparing you for eternity. Put on the whole armour of God and walk in His footsteps. He didn't promise us that life would be easy, but He did promise us that He would give us strength to stand.
